Total fund allocated: approx. £21,180

Key Indicator 1: Engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity	£6130
Review: Our Sports coach worked with pupils in year 5 and 6 to help develop them as play leaders. Unfortunately due to the children being in bubbles they were not allowed to mix with other groups. However they did learn key skills which they can either use next year or at high school. All funding spent	
Key Indicator 2: The profile of PE and sport is raised across school as a tool for whole school improvement	£1000
Review: We were not able to complete this due to Covid guidelines and visitors being limited. - funding to be rolled over	
Key Indicator 3: Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching of PE and sport	£6000
Review: The work on this began in the summer term. PE leader is in place and working with sports coach to develop whole school planning. Time spent with a member of SLT to develop role. Funding partially spent. £4000 rolled over.	
Key Indicator 4: Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils	£2025
Review: Some after school clubs ran in the summer term for the classes who were already using the PE coach so bubbles were not crossed. All funding spent	
Key Indicator 5: Increased participation in competitive sport	£1750
Review: This could not happen as staff could not cross bubbles. A whole school sports day was planned and carried out in the summer term. Some of the funding was used to plan and organise this. £750 spent.	
Contingency: £4275 of which £1500 has been spent on new equipment.
