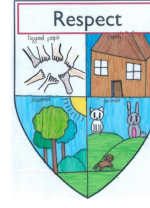

Have lovely weekend and take care.

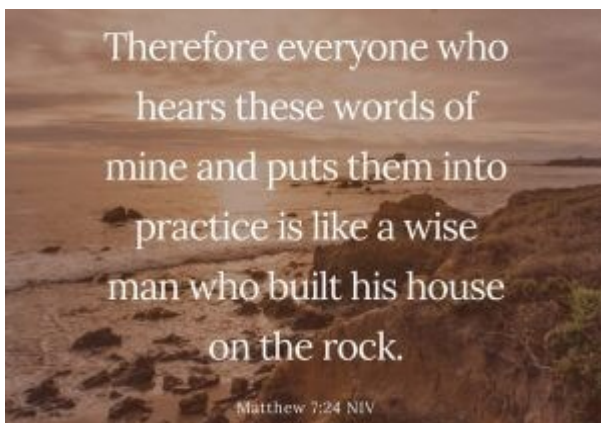
