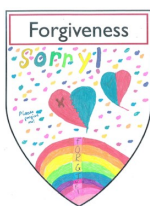

Before and After School Club

Our new after school provision will begin on Monday 7th June. It will be a Governor led provision and will initially be staffed by adults that the children already know while we run our recruitment process. Mrs Game will be there to meet the children for each session during the first week to ensure the children feel happy and safe within their club. We have met with some children this week to gain their views about what they would like their club to be and, in the weeks following half term, we will be asking parents, whose children attend the club, to do the same.

The children told us they would like to do more sports so we have employed a sports coach for the first half term from Tuesday-Friday. Weather permitting, they will be outside playing games and learning new skills.
