Our children have been very busy this Summer Term. We have celebrated St George's Day, the 80th Anniversary of the D-Day Landings as well as creating our own little garden area with outside wall decorations, planting strawberry and tomato plants along with painting pebbles – it does look very pretty and colourful out there. Hopefully our children may be able to taste their home grown produce very soon.

We are currently in the 'throws' of Euro 2024. Our children have their own wall board, which they have decorated with a fixtures list, bunting and stickers and our children enjoy updating the fixtures list each morning. Football matches will be available for children to watch in either the hall or outdoor classroom area if match times are during Club hours.

Our children have continued to enjoy the Breakfast Club sports activities in the Lower Hall, Lower School Playground or the field from 7.50 am to 8.30 am. We will also continue to offer play activities prior to school in the outdoor classroom area. At the After School Club, we also offer sports activities for our children in the Lower Hall, Lower School Playground or on the field, weather permitting.
